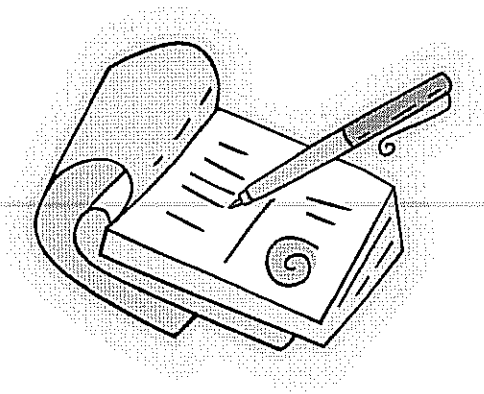

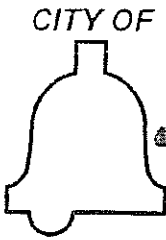

Re: **STREET RESURFACING 2007/2008**

Dear San Rafael Resident:

The City of San Rafael will be starting its annual street resurfacing project. Your street or a nearby street will be resurfaced between late August and mid November of this year. **Please refer to the reverse side of this letter for a listing of the streets to be resurfaced.**

Work will be performed in five phases; there may be a delay of 1 to 2 weeks during the various phases of construction. While the resurfacing work is being done, please keep children and pets away from the street as large equipment is involved and the asphalt is **very hot**.

The five work phases are as follows:

- 1. ADA Curb Ramps.** In street corners where there is adequate access such as sidewalks, curb ramps will be installed with truncated domes.
- 2. Grinding.** For streets with curb and gutter, grinding will be 6 feet on both sides of the street from the edge of gutter. The edges of the street adjacent to the gutter will be ground down to 2-1/2" to allow for the new asphalt. The street will be rough at the edge and bumpy at either end. Please use caution when driving during this time. Areas where asphalt pavement was removed for a base failure repair, will be removed and replaced with new asphalt.
- 3. Paving.** The street will be resurfaced with new asphalt paving. It takes about a 1/2 day to pave a street. There may be some minor delays during the actual paving operation when access will be limited. In most cases one lane of traffic will be open and you will be able to get into and out of your driveway. On narrow hillside streets, the contractor may close portions of the street. Please be patient if you are delayed during this work. Also, it is recommended not to drive into your driveway, if you drive over the tar that is applied prior to paving or immediately after the street is paved; this may cause black tire marks in your driveway.
- 4. Manhole, Rodhole and Monument Adjustment.** Following completion of the paving, a small work crew will start raising or lowering the manholes to the level of the new street surface.
- 5. Striping and Pavement Markings.** A paint crew will re-apply road stripings and markings to the new street surface.

**IMPORTANT "Traffic Control and Safety."** Prior to grinding and paving operations, the Contractor will post "NO PARKING-TOW AWAY" signs and barricades on the streets to be resurfaced approximately 48 hours before start of construction. **Please do not park your car in the street on the date and time shown on the sign. Your car will be towed at your expense.**



For your safety and the safety of the construction workers, we request that the traffic control signs be observed at all times during the construction period.

Newly paved asphalt is susceptible to grooving by sharp turning and hard braking. Minimizing this will help the new pavement last longer and provide for a smoother surface.

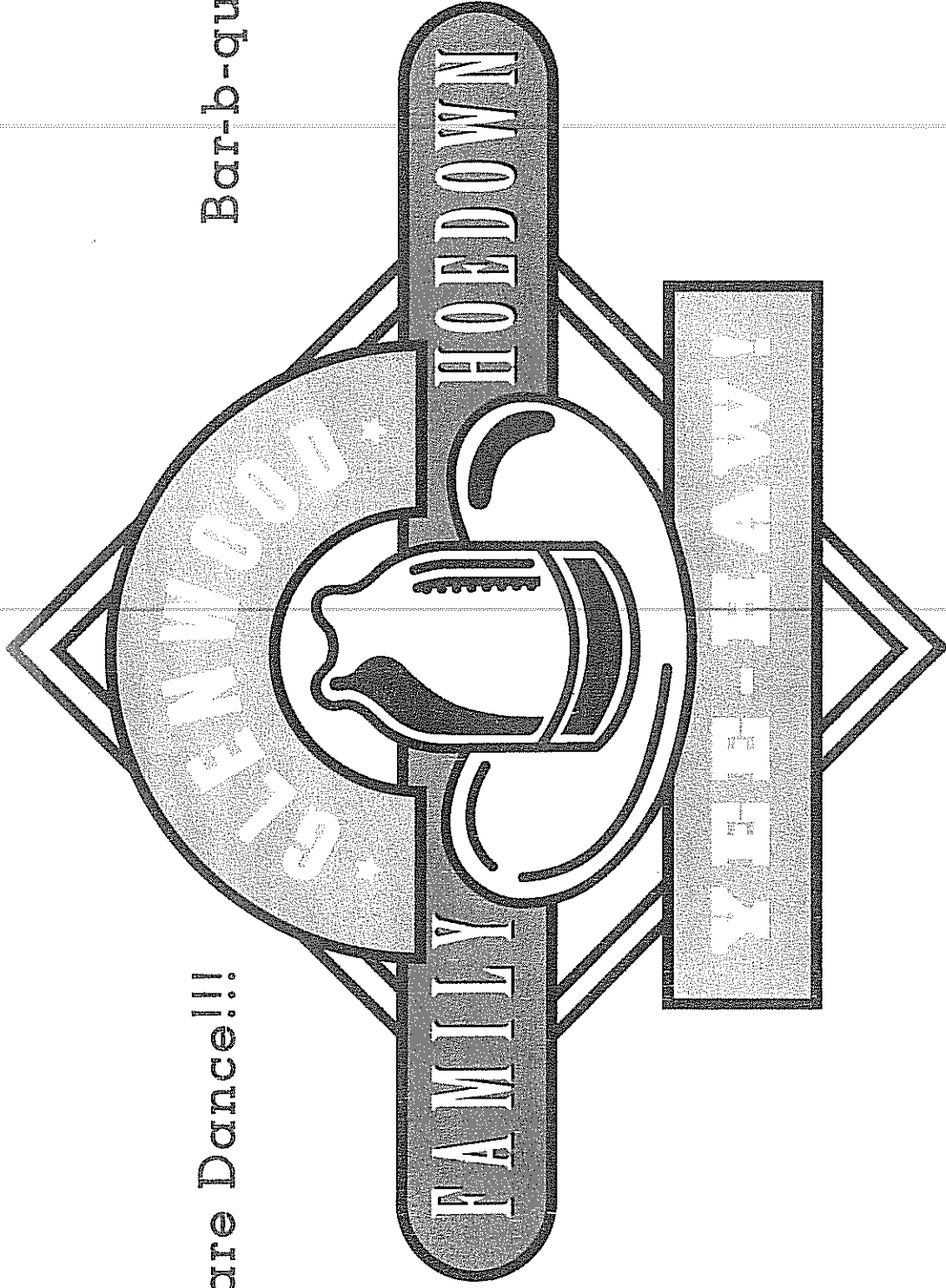
