will present a slide show, and answer some questions.

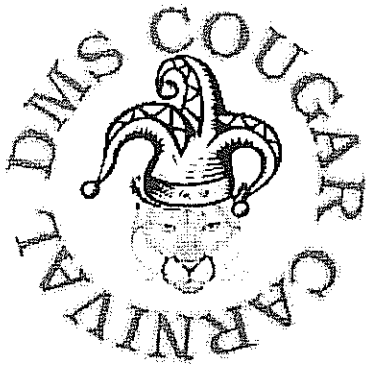
