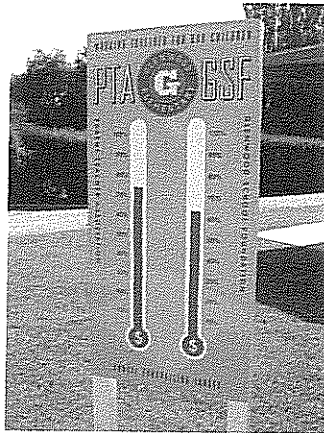

Dear Parents:

The members of the Multicultural Committee apologize for the inaccurate information presented in the first clue of the first multicultural quiz. The original information was taken out-of-context from Wikipedia.

As a preview of what your kids will be enjoying next week, we would like to give you an overview of Multicultural Week. We hope the week will be a great cultural experience for the students of Glenwood.

We will kick off Multicultural week with our first assembly at 9:30 and 10:45 Monday, June 1st. This assembly will feature **Chitresh Das Dance Company**, an Indian dance company, which will perform Kathak, a classical dance developed in the Hindu temples and Muslim courts. The dance features rapid, percussive footwork and turns, intricate rhythm, elaborate hand gestures and rich story telling to melodic song.

Tuesday and Wednesday are *Passport Days*. This year the students will visit Austria, England, Egypt, Guatemala, Italy, Lebanon, Nepal, Russia and the Palestinian Territories. Don't forget to ask your kids about the places they visited.

Thursday our assembly will be at 9:30 and 10:45. **Capoeira Mandinga** a group that performs capoeira, a Brazilian art-form that incorporates music, dance, acrobatics, self-defense and singing and is said to have influenced break-dancing. Once forbidden by law, capoeira was created by African slaves as way to facilitate freedom. A graceful, exciting dance form, capoeira is a melding the African, Portuguese and Brazilian cultures, and an excellent example of the importance of diversity, mutual respect and cooperation between people of all races, genders and spiritual beliefs.

On Friday, we will again have *Around the World Day*, which is focused on involving the students in fun, hands-on learning. Each classroom will be decorating a box based on a country. The boxes will be displayed Friday morning from 8:45 to 11:30 in the Multi-Purpose Room, and the kids will have questions that they can answer based on the boxes.

Please join us on Friday at 12:40 on the blacktop for the final *Around the World* celebration. We will be treated to a performance by the Glenwood students who attend Taylor's House of Karate and acknowledge all that the children learned during Multicultural Week.
